- Onsite GP clinic (Northridge)
- Onsite hairdresser
- Pharmacy deliveries



Something for everyone

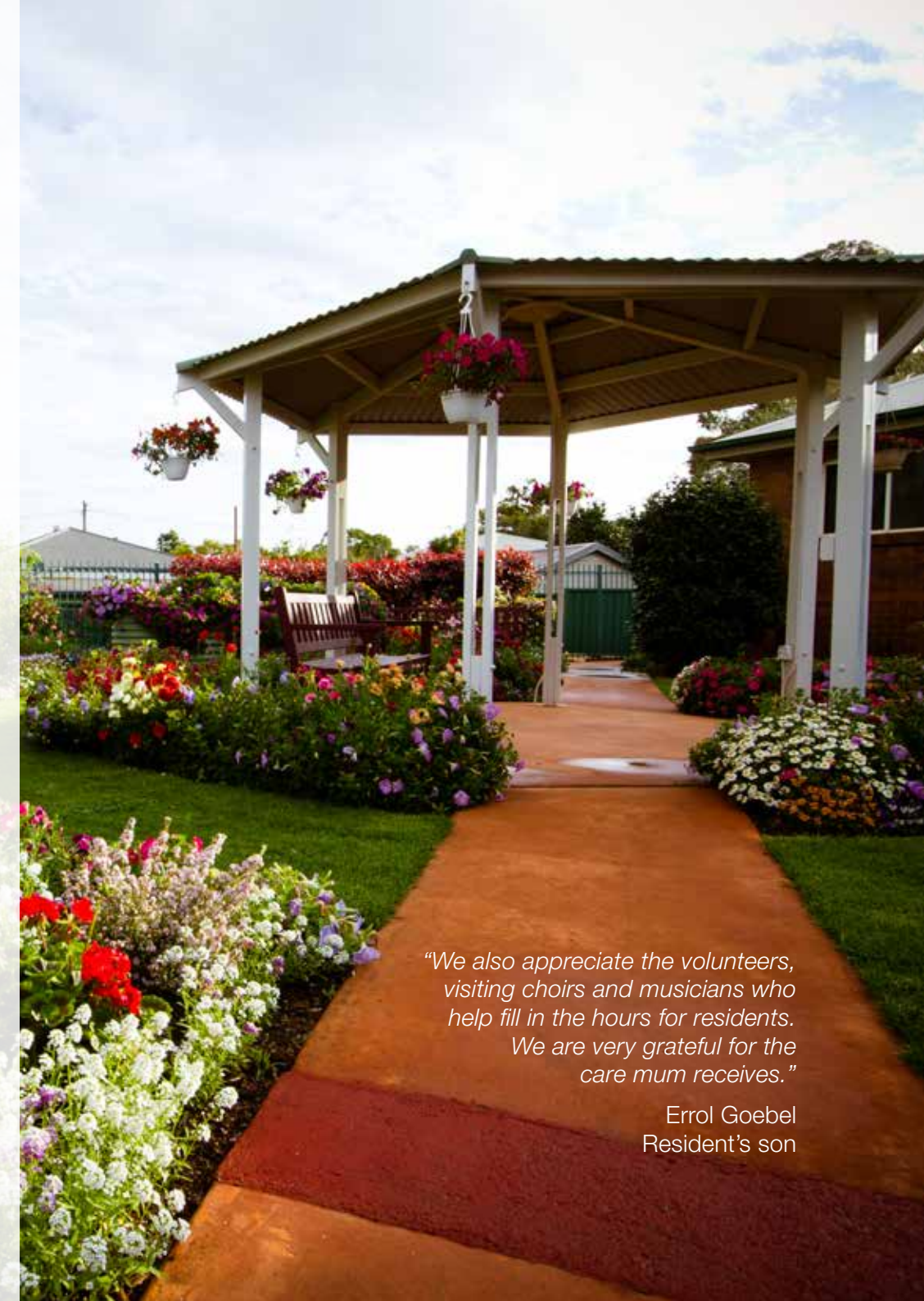
